Rep. Katsma Honored as League Legislative Champion

Sheboygan – The League of Wisconsin Municipalities presented Rep. Terry Katsma (R-Oostburg) with the association’s Municipal Champion award at last night’s meeting of the Sheboygan City Council. The League’s Deputy Director, Curt Witynski, joined Mayor Mike Vandersteen and the Council in presenting Rep. Katsma with a clock in honor of his strong support for Wisconsin’s municipalities and local control.

The Representative was highlighted as one of eight Municipal Champions in June’s *The Municipality* magazine:

Representative Terry Katsma is a former member of the Oostburg Village Board. Last session, Rep, Katsma authored, at the League’s request, Act 78, which removes the three-year maximum term on certificates of deposit and allows cities and villages to invest in time deposits with any length of maturity. He also worked with the City of Milwaukee on authoring and guiding to passage Act 339, establishing minimum qualifications for third-party bidders seeking to participate in mortgage foreclosure sales. In addition, Rep. Katsma was an early co-sponsor of both the dark store and Walgreens reversal bills.

The League of Wisconsin Municipalities advocates for Wisconsin’s cities and villages, provides legal services to members, as well as training and networking opportunities. Established in 1898 for purposes of advocacy, the League continues that strong legacy.
