### **Task Force on City Government Seeking Ideas and Information**

The Madison Common Council, last year created a special task force on city government to examine and make recommendations on the structure and powers of the Mayor's Office, Common Council, and the City's Boards, Commissions, and Committees.

The task force has been meeting monthly since February and plans to issue a report with recommendations to the Common Council in mid-2019. The Task Force is currently collecting information and input from current and former government officials in preparation for conducting a larger public outreach process.
